"Save the Sundial Monument" in limbo

At the Feb. 24, 2011, RCSC Board meeting, on behalf of himself and Anne Randall Stewart (spokesperson for The Sun City Formula Registry and publisher of http://www.annereport.com), Noel Kasper delivered a request for a petition to bring to a Membership vote the "Save the Sundial Monument" issue.

BEGIN TEXT OF SPEECH:

I have delivered to the board a letter dated today, on behalf of myself and Anne Randall Stewart, Member 88242, requesting a petition to circulate among the RCSC Members to "Save the Sundial Monument" through a Membership vote.

The language is:

"The undersigned current RCSC Member Cardholders in good standing, hereby sign a petition for the following: to bring about a Membership vote to Save the Sundial Monument." The ballot will read: "I approve saving the Sundial Monument".

If the board votes to cancel its plans to destroy this priceless and famous Del Webb Monument, we will cancel the petition drive and save the community from unwanted division and an expensive voting process. However, we need a definitive cancellation, or we must proceed to stop it through Membership action: A Membership Vote. This action should halt any imminent plans for demolition until a Membership vote outcome is known.

The RCSC was established for the purpose of maintaining and protecting the Del Webb facilities and landmarks gifted to the people of Sun City so

that they will endure for future generations. It is not the purpose of this RCSC board of directors to destroy Del Webb landmarks and historic monuments.

We thank you for listening to our concerns that we believe are shared by the Members. We are a Del Webb community in perpetuity. It is the fiduciary duty of the RCSC Board of Directors to steer the "Ship" in that direction and if they do not it is the obligation of the Members to stop them. *END TEXT OF SPEECH*

Membership action stopped the destruction of a world-famous Del Webb icon.

Since the board convened a board meeting with a quorum in closed session (which is not allowed), we do not trust the validity of their vote to "Save the Sundial Monument." We need to have a vote in open session for us to trust the vote.

Until it is a legal certainty that the board will not destroy the Sundial Monument, our petition request stands as security that the demolition cannot go forward as long as there is membership action against it.

Circulators, please stand by and don't relax until the monument is restored to its original glory.
