PCA bill passed in House committee

Still faces further debate

A revived bill to exempt Recreation Centers of Sun City from operating under the state's Planned Communities Act was passed in a House committee.

The House Government Committee approved moving the bill forward in a 6-5 vote March 28. The bill now moves to the House Rules Committee. If passed there, it will be debated on the House floor before a full vote. If the bill, now known as Senate Bill 1094, makes it through the House it will return to the Senate for the process there, which includes hearings in the Government and Rules committees and, if it survives those panels, debate and a vote on the Senate floor.
